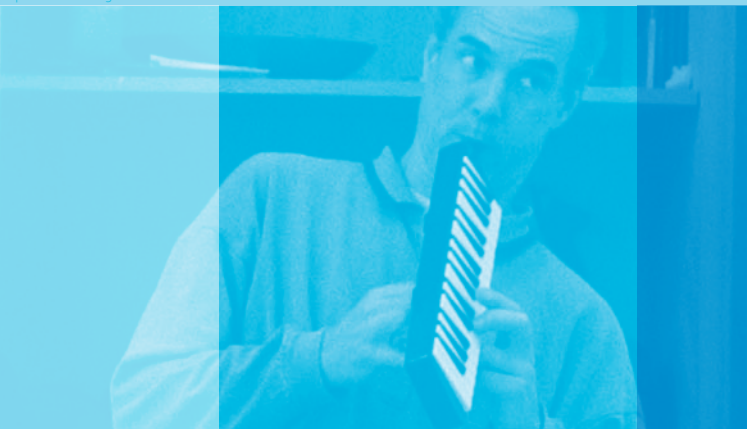
Nancy Stark Smith

first trained as an athlete and gymnast, leading her to study and perform modern and post-modern dance in the early 1970's. She danced in the first performances of Contact Improvisation in 1972 and has since then been centrally involved in its development as dancer, teacher, performer, writer/publisher and organizer. She travels worldwide teaching and performing contact and other improvised dance work, collaborating with many favorite dance partners and performance makers including Steve Paxton, Karen Nelson, Andrew Harwood, Julyen Hamilton, and more recently musician Mike Vargas. In 1975 she co-founded Contact Quarterly dance journal, which she continues to edit and produce.

Mike Vargas

began studying music in 1959. His curiosity and love of collaboration have led him through a very wide variety of contexts and cultures, from Indonesian cocktail lounges to underground clubs on New York's Lower East Side, from New Music America to Playback Theater and the Kennedy Center. Though improvising is a priority, he has released five CDs to date and has composed commissioned scores for over 50 choreographers, among them Bebe Miller, Liz Lerman, Barbara Dilley, and Brenda Buffalino. Vargas has taught improvisation at the Bates Dance Festival, Tanzsommer Innsbruck, Naropa University, and many colleges across the U.S. For the past seven years, he has been working with Nancy Stark Smith.

Contact, Music, and 86 Aspects of Composition

In this workshop, we will dance, listen, watch, and dance some more. We will combine our practice of Contact Improvisation with the pleasure and discipline of listening to sound. In addition to deepening and refining our C.I. skills and practice, we will work with C.I. in combination with many species of live and recorded music as well as ambient sound. While maintaining a strong kinesthetic base of sensation and physical awareness, we will practice perceiving the composition of our environment, of movement, and of sound, separately and together. Using Mike's 86 aspects of composition as a reference and common language, we will develop a greater understanding of how things are organized and apply this understanding to our dancing, listening, and improvising in C.I. In addition, there will be hands-on music-making exercises to help us feel the weight and organization of sound from the inside.

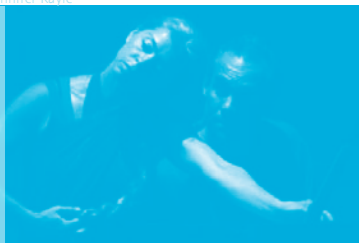
Our goal is to promote a variety of specific, conscious relationships between what we hear and how we move. In solos, duets, trios and larger ensembles, we'll use the physical principles of C.I. to improvise dances that are deeply felt and at the same time in contact with the sound and the organization of the world around us.
